Parks committee approves Casey

The Suffolk Legislature's parks committee yesterday unanimously approved Attorney Jennifer A. Casey of Huntington Station to become a member of the Suffolk County Planning Commission.

Casey, whose appointment will come up for a vote before the full county legislature in Hauppauge next Tuesday, has been a member of the Huntington economic development corporation as well as Huntington's downtown economic revitalization committee.

Casey, if confirmed, will fill the town representative spot that previously had been held by Sarah Lansdale, who recently was hired as the county's planning director.

Casey said in testimony that there was a need for public education about what makes for good planning, noting that there are "a lot of misperceptions out there."
